Date

Relay For Life/ American Cancer Society: Relay For Life (Relay) is the main volunteer-driven cancer fundraising event of the American Cancer Society. The first Relay was held in 1986 in Tacoma, Washington, and Relays have been held annually in Williamsburg since 2000. Although the main objective of Relay For Life is to raise money for cancer research and cancer patients, the event is held to spread cancer awareness, celebrate the lives of survivors, remember those who lost their lives to cancer, and unite a community in the fight against cancer.

Directions:

From I-64/Newport News: Take exit 242A (toward Jamestown) and Rt. 199 West. Take the Monticello Avenue exit (Rt. 321) off of 199 and make a left at the bottom of the ramp onto 321 West (Monticello Ave.). Proceed west on Monticello Ave., through the intersection with Centerville Road (Rt. 614) and straight through the Rt. 5000/Rt. 5 intersection onto Rt. 5 West. Make first left on Two Rivers Road into the Governor's Land residential community, and follow signs to Park East.

From Richmond Road (Rt. 60): Turn south onto Rt. 614 (Centerville Rd.) and proceed south on 614 to the light at Monticello Ave. (7.3 miles). Turn right onto Monticello Ave. and proceed through next light onto Rt. 5 West. Follow directions above.

Schedule:

7:30 a.m. - Race day registration & packet pickup opens 9:00 a.m. - 5K Run/Walk

8:30 a.m. - One Mile Fun Run/Walk

10:15 a.m. - Awards ceremony. Door prizes. Refreshments.

Course:

Flat, fast, scenic, certified (VA-07030-RT) 5K course through the Governor's Land residential community. Out-and-back on Two Rivers Road, with horseshoe loops of Horne's Lake and Whittaker Island neighborhoods on return trip. All paved roads.

Awards:

All pre-registered entrants in the 5K race receive a beautiful long-sleeve t-shirt. Shirts will be given to race-day entrants while supplies last. Awards in the 5K run to the top three overall men and women, and to the top three in five-year age groups for men and women, from 14-and-under through 70-and-over. 5K walk awards go to the top five men and women.
