



## RACE INFORMATION GUIDE

### Packet Pickup

**Dates:** Thursday, January 23 and Friday, January 24, 2020

**Times:** 10am - 6pm

**Location:** Hilton Garden Inn at SeaWorld at 6850 Westwood Blvd, Orlando, FL 32821

We encourage all participants for the Fun Run and Kids Races to pick up their packets on Thursday or Friday prior to race day. You can pick up for other friends and family members as well, please just be sure to notify them that you are picking up their packet.

Race Day packet pick up is available at SeaWorld Orlando on Race Day beginning at 5:45AM. Please allow additional time to pick up your packet on race day due to parking and potentially long lines. Pre purchased theme park tickets and spectator Killer Whale Presentation tickets can be picked up at packet pick up.

### Registration for the Kids Run

Following the fun run, we will host a KIDS RUN! All kids must be registered in order to run. We highly recommend registering for the Kids Run prior to race morning as this event may reach capacity prior to race day. [Click here to register for the Kids Run.](#)

### Race Day Parking

Parking is free for participants in the SeaWorld parking lots. Please note that the parking lot will close at 6:45am and reopen at 7:45am.

### Race Day Timeline

- 5:45am - Registration and Packet Pickup opens (near SeaWorld main entrance)
- 6:45am - Parking lot closes - please plan to be onsite at least 45 minutes prior to start
- 7:00am - START of the FUN RUN
- 7:30am - Finish line festival begins with SeaWorld animals and characters
- 7:45am - SeaWorld main entrance and parking reopens
- 8:00am - Kids Races packet pick up reopens in the finish line festival area
- 8:00am - Awards Ceremony (near the finish line area)
- 8:30am - Kids Run start
- 9:15am - Killer Whale Educational Presentation experience (20-25 minute show)





### Weather

Races will be held rain or shine, however, if there is severe weather in the area the race start may be delayed or cancelled. As a reminder, registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Safety

In order to ensure the safety of all runners, bicycles, roller skates, in-line skates, baby carriers and dogs are prohibited from the race course. It is VERY important for you to stay alert throughout the race, stay inside cones and obey all race signage. Jogging strollers are permitted but must start in the back.



## Fun Run Awards

Awards will go to the top 3 overall Male and Female finishers only in the Fun Run. There will be a clock at the finish line for everyone to see their finish times.

## Strollers

Strollers are allowed in the Fun Run. Nurturing future generations of runners is a priority and demonstrating healthy lifestyles to our kids is special. We do ask those registrants participating with a stroller, must line up after the runners & walkers at the start line. Please listen for directions on where to line up on the day of the race. Only paid registrants of the Fun Run will receive a finisher medal. If you would like your child to receive the medal, you will have to register them for the Fun Run event.

## Kids Race Course + Meeting Location

Please plan to meet at the post-race festival area by Shamu Stadium (see map). We will escort each age group to the finish line at 8:30am. Parents are welcome to run with their child or wait for their child at the finish line area. Each child will receive a finisher medal + a special item from SeaWorld!



The Kids Races will run around Shamu Stadium for easy access to the post-race Killer Whale Presentation Show. Distances will range from 50yd to 200yd depending on age. Age groups will run in the following order:

- 4 and under
- 5-6 years old
- 7 years old
