Hundreds of Indiana athletes battle it out in annual CrossFit competition to raise \$200,000+ for Wheeler Mission

INDIANAPOLIS - September 20, 2025 - On Saturday, nearly 400 athletes from 30+ Indiana CrossFit gyms will battle it out in the 12th annual Strength in Our Streets competition, benefiting Wheeler Mission. This unique, one-day, co-ed team event combines the intensity of CrossFit with the power of philanthropy—and promises both unforgettable visuals and inspiring human-interest stories for local media.

Since its founding in 2014, participating athletes have raised more than \$1.8 million to help Hoosiers experiencing homelessness, hunger, and addiction. Already this year, competitors have raised \$180,000+, with fundraising continuing through the end of Saturday's competition.
