We encourage caution while on the trail. The race will start and end on a paved road. We will have signs, flagging and volunteers on the course to help direct runners.

TRANSFERS

Transfers are available through October 30th. DO NOT give your bib to someone else. Everyone needs to register and sign a waiver. Unauthorized transfers will cause issues with our awards since the awards are based on registration information. No race transfers on race day.

1. Does everyone receive a finisher medal?
 - a. Yes!
