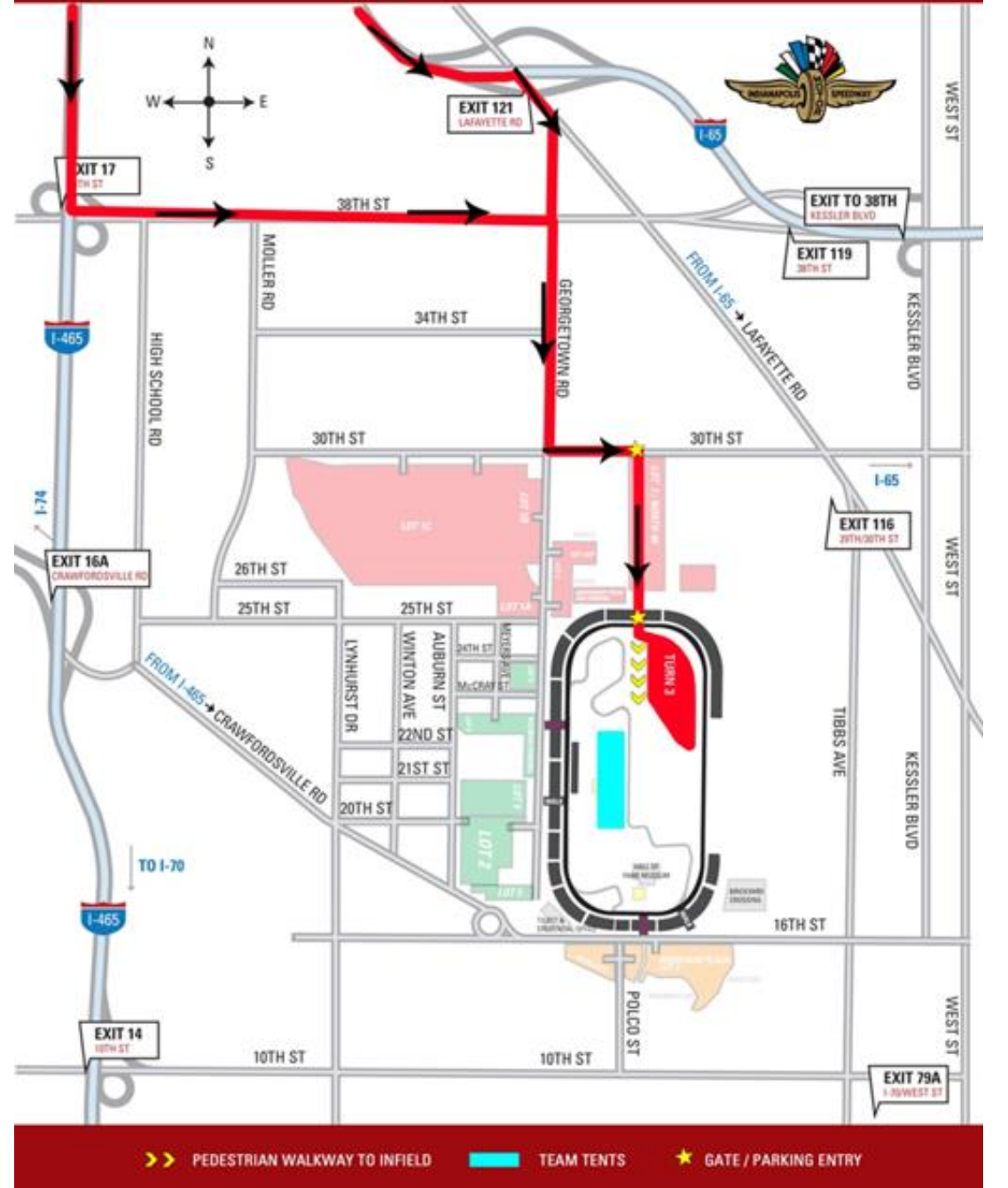
APPROACHING FROM EAST, WEST & SOUTH
