During the past 8 races, the morning was cloudy and rainy while the volunteers arrived and set up the signage, registration tents. Members of the sponsor Eatontown Lions Club, the NJ Blind Citizens Association, and the true facilitator - the Jersey Shore Running Club – have worked to tempt the forecast and hold the event.

I am pleased to announce that in the face of driving winds, coastline flood advisories and winds that exceeded 40 mph – once again – the rain stopped ten minutes before the start of the race and waited until we had cleaned up to resume pummeling the coast. 70 runners, walkers and a determined seeing eye puppy named Yuki - took their positions on the starting line and completed the 15th Lighthouse Run. The wind gusts provided some interesting challenges as some wondered if the run might turn into a swim given that the run takes place entirely along the bay!

Thanks to the dedication of the runners and volunteers, we were able to exceed our donation targets for the NJ Blind Citizens Association and Camp Happiness – a local NJ bayside resource dedicated to aiding those in the community.
