We are in the same situation for 2022 and would like to request the board's approval to do the same thing again for this year."

# Thanks Dad 5k - June 19 (Allison May, Eric Nachman)

Allison noted that registration is about 100 people and they would like more. Recently registrations have peaked the week before the race. A few more volunteers are needed at the finish line.

## Cul de Sac series - July 4, 11, 18 (Mike Gholson)

All permits are in hand and we have 226 runners registered as of June 3rd.

Looks like July 4th is really looking good for a big turn out.

We have 200 goodr sunglasses in hand and we may have to order more which is a good thing.

Mike noted that the goal was 300 registrants.

### Pony Pasture - July 23 (Mara George & Sarah Golightly)

We will not have shuttle vans this year because we couldn't find any to rent. It will be chipped timed since Anne will not be driving a van. Everything else should be the same as years past.

Mara noted that about 75 people have signed up. The police have given a verbal okay. Shirts will be ordered at the beginning of July.

The race will be the RRCA-Virginia 5k championship. Michael George has agreed to certify the course!
